Partial Closure of Jean Teague Greenway

For Water System Work

KUB crews will close a short section of Jean Teague Greenway starting at 8:30 p.m. Tuesday, May 2, to perform work on the water distribution system in the area. This work is expected to last through 6 a.m., Wednesday, May 3, with KUB's paving contractor completing full greenway restoration before 3 p.m. The closed section of greenway is adjacent to North Gallaher View Road, near the Ivy Falls Way intersection. All other portions of the greenway will remain open. There is no detour available for the closed section of greenway.
