Partial Closure of Neyland Greenway

For Wastewater System Work

KUB and its contractor will close a short section of Neyland Greenway starting at 6 a.m. Tuesday, February 7, to begin wastewater system repair work. This work is expected to last through mid March. The closed section of greenway is the approximately 1,400 foot segment adjacent to Neyland Drive on the northern bank of the Tennessee River (south of Neyland Drive, across the street from KUB's Kuwahee Wastewater Treatment Plant). All other portions of the greenway will remain open. There is no detour available for the closed section of greenway.
